La Crosse Rifle Club Range Rules

Revised 4/2018

- 1) Immediately upon uncasing any gun on the shooting range, the action shall be opened, safety on, and magazine removed until ready to fire. Carry firearms (concealed or open carry) will not be handled in the clubhouse while in loaded condition. All unloading and loading of firearms will be done on the designated shooting range.
- 2) There shall be no consumption of alcohol by any person before shooting or while they are shooting on any designated range. No one shall shoot at any time if they show evidence of being under the influence of alcohol or any other intoxicant.
- 3) The warning flag shall be placed at the 600 yard line at all times when anyone is shooting on the 200 or 300 yard lines, whenever anyone is working downrange or otherwise present north of the 600 yard line. A warning flag shall be flown in the pits whenever anybody is firing on the 200, 300, or 600 yard lines. Additionally an orange safety cone will be placed on one of the concrete shooting benches when anyone is downrange.
- 4) All firing shall be on designated ranges at targets properly hung on the frames or carriers provided, or placed directly on the impact berm so that bullets are stopped immediately behind the target.
- 5) There shall be no shooting at objects made of glass or other material that will break into sharp fragments and there will be no intentional shooting at range equipment.
- 6) All shooters shall make every effort to assure that their firearms are properly sighted in so as to minimize damage to target carriers or frames.
- 7) No tracer or incendiary ammunition shall be fired on the range without permission of the Board of Directors. No explosive devices, dynamite, or other high explosives shall be detonated on the Club grounds without permission of the Board of Directors.
- 8) There shall be no shooting during the absence of light unless approved by a member of the Board of Directors.
- 9) No weapon capable of full automatic operation shall be fired on the range without permission of the Board of Directors.
- 10) There shall be no building or placement of permanent structures, such as outbuildings or target carriers, without permission of the Board of Directors.
- 11) Hunting on Club property is prohibited except by permission of the Board of Directors.
- 12) Members of the La Crosse Rifle Club shall be responsible for the conduct of any guests that they invite to the shooting range and the member shall be present at all times with their guests.
- 13) The gate will be closed at all times except during times that meetings, matches, or classes are being conducted on Club property. The gate will be closed and locked by the last person leaving Club property.
- 14) Violation of any of the above range rules shall be noted and the violator asked to correct their error; if not corrected, the violation will be reported to the Board of Directors for possible disciplinary action.
