Match 3 – 300 Yard Prone Rapid Fire. 2 Sighting Shots in 2 Min. 2-10 Rd Strings Rapid Fire 70 Seconds.

Match 4 – 600 Yard Prone Slow Fire. 2 Sighting Shots, 20 Rounds for Record in 22 Minutes.

RULES: NRA or CMP Rules will apply as applicable.

CATEGORIES: To qualify in the NRA MATCH, PALMA or SERVICE Rifle Categories, you must shoot that type of gun as NRA

rules apply ALL day.

AWARDS: Cash Awards. There must be 5 competitors in a class or special category to receive cash awards. Checks

mailed end of season.

SCORING 1: Competitors will score via Shot Marker Electronic Target System. Please bring a devise to use to read your

shots and scores.

SCORING 2: Score Keepers will need to verify the shooter is on target and then required to watch the shooter execute each

shot for score.

EXTRA SHOTS: You will be required to report all extra shots on your target to a range official.

PITS: No Pit Duty except to volunteer to change/replace target centers & put targets away. Target Centers changed

after 80 rounds.
