- Entries:** Entries limited to range capacity of 45 competitors. All score cards must be turned in after each stage and at the end of the match.
- Rules:** CMP rules will apply. It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with the current rules and appropriate equipment requirements. Empty chamber indicators are required
- Eligibility:** EIC Match is open to all eligible competitors.

- Sharing Equipment:** Competitors needing to share equipment should make it known at time of entry.
- Awards:** Awards for the winners of the EIC Match will come from CMP.
- SCORING 1:** Competitors will score via Shot Marker Electronic Target System.  
**Please bring a device to use to read your shots and scores.**
- SCORING 2:** Score Keepers will need to verify the shooter is on target & required to watch the shooter execute each shot for score.

## Course of Fire, 50 Shot National Match Course:

- 10 shots slow fire from the standing position at 200 yards in a time limit of 10 minutes.
- 10 shots rapid fire from the sitting or kneeling position at 200 yards in a time limit of 60 seconds.
- 10 shots rapid fire from the prone position at 300 yards in a time limit of 70 seconds.
- 20 shots slow fire from the prone position at 600 yards in a time limit of 20 minutes.

Note: No sighting shots, competitors will stand before each rapid fire stage. Both the standing and sitting stages will be completed before the competitor leaves the 200 yard firing line.
