Match 1 – 200 Yard Offhand Slow Fire. 2 Sighing Shots, 20 Rds for Record, 22 Minutes.

Match 2 – 200 Yard Sitting Rapid Fire. 2 Sighting Shots, 2 Min. 2-10 Rd Strings Rapid Fire 60 Seconds. Match 3 – 300 Yard Prone Rapid Fire. 2 Sighting Shots, 2 Min. 2-10 Rd Strings Rapid Fire 70 Seconds.

2 Sighting Shots, 20 Rds for Record, 22 Minutes. Match 4 – 600 Yard Prone Slow Fire.

Match 5 – Slow Fire Aggregate = Agg. of Matches 1 & 4. Match 6 – Rapid Fire Aggregate = Agg. of Matches 2 & 3. Match 7 – Grand Aggregate = Agg. of Matches 1 thru 4.
