Sunday 4-Gun 600 Yards Slow Fire Prone

2 sighters & 20 rounds for record per match

Match 6: Any/Any, NRA Match, Palma, Service, F-Class
Match 7: Any/Any, NRA Match, Palma, Service, F-Class
Match 8: Any/Iron, NRA Match, Palma, Service, F-Class
Match 9: Any/Iron, NRA Match, Palma, Service, F-Class
Match 10: Day two aggregate, matches 6 through 9

Match 11: Two-day aggregate of matches 5 and 10.

Rules NRA [Mid-Range Prone](#) and NRA [Mid-Range F-Class](#) rules will apply. **Extra shots must be reported to range official.** No fouling shots during the match.

Categories To qualify for NRA Match, Palma, or Service Rifle categories, shooter **must** shoot that type of gun as NRA rules apply all day.

Scoring Competitors will score via Shot Marker electronic target system. **Shooters must bring device (tablet or phone) to read shots and scores.** Score keepers will need to verify the shooter is on target and then required to watch shooter execute each shot for score.

Awards Cash awards for class and category winners mailed after match.

Other No pit duty except volunteers to replace target centers. Target centers changed after 80 rounds. All shooters and observers must complete club release of liability form.
